

- **Funerals:** Please contact the parish office before scheduling or publishing (generally through a funeral director). *Bereavement committee available for hospitality.*
- **Sponsor Certificates:** May be obtained by registered, practicing members of our parish who have received the three sacraments of initiation: Baptism, Confirmation and the Eucharist (and, if Married, were married in the church).

Greetings of Peace as we begin the Second week of our Advent journey. Christmas is 2-1/2 weeks away!

This weekend we will take up a *second collection* to support the annual "Retirement for Religious" appeal. The Catholic Bishops of the United States launched the Retirement Fund for Religious 31 years ago to address the profound shortage in retirement funding among communities of women and men religious. Most senior religious ministered for years for small stipends, leaving their congregations with

insufficient retirement savings. Additionally, rising health-care costs and decreased income compound the struggle to provide adequate care.

So I ask you to please give to those who have given a lifetime. Thank you.

On Monday, December 9, 2019 we will celebrate the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Usually this Solemnity (and often a Holy Day of Obligation) is celebrated on December 8. But not this year. The United States Bishops explain, "Since December 8, 2019 is the Second Sunday of Advent, the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary is transferred to Monday, December 9, 2019. The obligation to attend Mass, however, does not transfer." Therefore, there is no obligation to attend mass on the Immaculate Conception in 2019. That requirement to abrogated this year.

Since Chirstmas is 2-1/2 weeks away, please note our St. Joan of Arc 2019 Christmas mass schedule:

- Christmas Eve, Tuesday December 24: 4:00 PM, 6:00 PM, and 9:00 PM
- Christmas Day, Wednesday December 25: 9:00 AM and 11:00 AM


PSR Christmas Break
