Greetings of Peace.

Lent begins in 1-1/2 weeks on Ash Wednesday, February 26. For your "planning," our **parish masses on Ash Wednesday** (with the distribution of Ashes) **are 9:00 AM and 7:00 PM**. In addition, we will have a **Liturgy of the Word with Ashes at 12:00 noon**. Thank you for making a note about our Ash Wednesday schedule.



There are some church guidelines for the Fridays in Lent, and particularly for both Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.

All Fridays in Lent (and Ash Wednesday) are days of Abstinence - which means all Catholics 14 years old and older are to **Abstain from Meat.**

Moreover, **Ash Wednesday** and **Good Friday**, in addition to being days of Abstinence, **are Days of Fast.** Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59 are to **Fast** on both Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.

How's this for a simple description of each?

Fasting means, "one full meal, two other light meals." (Together, the "lighter meals" are not equivalent to the one main meal.)

Abstinence means "no meat."

It is prudent to remember there are cases and circumstances that excuse one from the obligations of Fast and/or Abstinence. Those who are "outside the age limits," those who may be physically or mentally ill (including individuals suffering from chronic illnesses - such as diabetes) are "exempt" from the "rules." Also excluded are pregnant or nursing women or others with physical needs, those who "exercise manual labor for a living," and such alike. In all cases, common sense should prevail, and no one should jeopardize their health by Fasting.



Last weekend, all the parishes in the Diocese of Cleveland participated in the "in pew process" for the **Annual Catholic Charities Appeal.** This year the Catholic Charities Appeal focuses on Pope Francis' teachings on "joy" and "accompaniment" as we are asked to see Christ in all our brothers and sisters, with the theme "Faces of Hope." **All registered households in the parish are asked to complete a Catholic Charities envelope** - even if we have replied by

mail to the appeal, received a letter from Catholic Charities, or from the bishop.

Those that may not have completed a Catholic Charities envelope are kindly asked to do so this weekend. Envelopes are available in the pews, in our church Gathering Area, in the Sacristy, and in the Parish Office. Completed envelopes can be placed in our regular collection or returned to the parish office. *Or, a response can be made with your smart phone, "Text to Give."* On your phone, open your texting app to a new message, type the number 41444, then type the word "CCHOPE" in the message area (it is one word and it does not matter if it is in caps or lower case). Hit Send and a reply message will be sent with a link to complete your donation. Thank you so much for your generous support of Catholic Charities.

Speaking of "giving and serving," we are blessed at St. Joan of Arc to have a vibrant community. These past weeks I am reminded of how many of our parishioners give of themselves in the many "ministries" offered at St. Joan of Arc. This is a tribute to you, our wonderful parishioners, and the many and varied ways you live your faith and reach out in generous service at St. Joan. I cannot express enough thanks to you. We are blessed. I am blessed.

Let's also take some time to recognize **our Staff who serve here at St. Joan of Arc Parish and Day School**.
