Greetings of Peace.

I recently received a communication from someone who went through much difficulty in life a few years ago. He was dealing personally with serious health issues, family problems, and more. He called these moments "lifequakes." He also wondered what helps us survive and thrive in times of difficulty and change.

He also said he realized, "In recent times, our world is going through a 'lifequake' together" with the CoVid crisis and all that goes along with it.

It seems that many of us are thinking about what is most meaningful to us in life. (Maybe "rethinking" is a better world). Yes, this is "serious stuff" and I hope you are doing well in the midst of "all this."

Locally, in our parish and diocese (and beyond) we are looking ahead to what "everything" will look like as we consider "moving forward" with "the virus" still very much in our sights. Questions need to be addressed regarding the opening of our parish day-school, PSR, possible parish "groups" and parish meetings, and more. I know similar questions are being asked for local schools and other groups in our community. We are receiving some "guiding principles" for consideration from the Diocese of Cleveland and are awaiting further clarity about some directives and guidelines.

As I have mentioned before, let's remain patient as we navigate through these unchartered waters and strive to remain safe and healthy. I like to use the words "prudent" and "practical."

Also, looking ahead, I will be out of town in a short while. I will be away from the parish after morning mass on Tuesday July 28 and return for the weekend masses of August 8-9. (This is "slightly extended" from my original plans - since I "lost" 2 weeks of vacation time due to our earlier lockdown a few months ago.) I will satisfy any mass intentions that are scheduled and for which I will not be here by celebrating mass when I am away.



Additionally, since I will not be here on Saturday-Sunday, August 1-2, we will not have public mass here that weekend. Finding a priest to cover any parish is becoming more problematic, especially during this pandemic. Since, the dispensation is still in effect and the obligation to attend mass is abrogated, there will not mass here the weekend of August 1-2. Thank you.

Again, please make a note that we will not have daily mass (or weekend mass) between July 29 and August 7. I appreciate your faith and your understanding. I will also write reminders in coming "columns" and will "post" this on the doors of the church.

If there is the need for a funeral or other emergency while I am way, the priests at our neighboring parishes may assist, as they are able. Thank you, Fathers. Have a blessed week, Let's persevere and stay well.




### SJA Prayer Line


