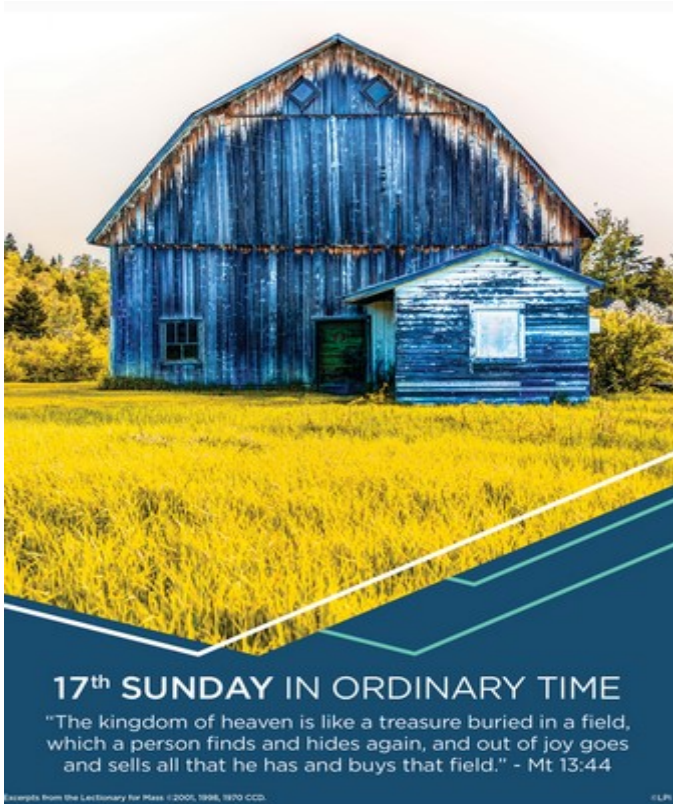

*From the Pastor's Desk*

Greetings of Peace.

**I will be out of town and away from the parish** (even with this CoVid "stuff" still going on.) I will be leaving after the morning mass on **Tuesday July 28** and will **return for the weekend masses of August 8-9**. I will satisfy any scheduled mass intentions by celebrating a "personal mass" when I am away.



And since I am out of town, **we will not have public mass at St. Joan of Arc the weekend of August 1-2**. *Finding a priest to cover any parish is becoming more problematic, especially during this pandemic.* Since, the dispensation is still in effect and the obligation to attend mass is abrogated, there will not mass here the weekend of August 1-2. Thank you.

Also note that we will **not have daily mass between July 29 and August 7**. I appreciate your faith and your understanding. A reminder is also "posted" on the doors of the church.

*If there is the need for a funeral or other emergency while I am way, the priests at our neighboring parishes may assist, as they are able. Thank you, Fathers.*

As we are looking ahead to the opening of school (hopefully at the end of August) we received word last week that our Principal, Mr. Dan Mitchell, is moving on to another school in our Diocese. Godspeed Mr. Mitchell and thank you for your service here at St. Joan of Arc. We are prioritizing our efforts to find the best person for our Parish School and have taken many steps in this direction already. Our school is "a gem" and be assured I have the very best interest of our students, families, faculty, and staff at heart.



Might I say **a word about donations and offerings to the church?** As your households continue to "operate" and your day-to-day living expenses continue, so too here at St. Joan of Arc.

Although the basket is not passed when we celebrate mass, **there are baskets in church for your donations** (in the Gathering Area and also in the middle of church at the "cross aisle."). "Offertory gifts" can also be **sent to us in the US Mail** or **contact the Parish Office** 440-247-7183 to arrange for "**automatic giving**" or to make a gift. **Online or "ACH" giving** may also be done through the parish website.

I am very aware that this pandemic has impacted so many of us in various ways. It has also impacted our parish and our cash flow. As I say this, I know that some of you are in a position where you cannot help our parish. My heart goes out to you. For those who can continue to help our parish, know of my sincere gratitude as well as the appreciation of our parish Ministerial Staff and our Parish Finance Council. **THANK YOU again.**

In a related matter, we usually take on some "Summer Projects" for our parish Buildings and Grounds. However, because of the CoVid crisis and its impact on our parish finances, we have delayed some of the work we had planned, unless the project is rather "urgent." Thank you again for your support and patience with us as we navigate through this pandemic.

## A Revised Roman Missal: The Words we Pray at Mass

In late 2011 we began the using the revised translation of *Roman Missal* at mass. This "project" was "in the works" since the Jubilee Year 2000, when Rome asked for an updating of the Missal used at mass. It is important to remember, **"The Mass did not change, the translation did."**

Vatican II called for the liturgy to be revised, simplified, and translated into the language of the people – after over 1,200 years of being celebrated in Latin (see "*Sacrosanctum Concilium*," Vatican II's document on the liturgy). The full and active participation of all people (not just the priest) was a primary focus of the Council. The Council also wanted people to better understand the liturgy.

The first English translation of the Roman Missal began in 1964 – seeking to capture the essential thoughts and images of the original Latin Missal. It went through two more revisions before the year 2000. Pope John Paul II called for a revision of the Roman Missal to include prayers for recently canonized saints, other Prefaces and Eucharistic Prayers, and the updating of some instructions (rubrics) for the celebration of the Mass. The official Latin text of this revision was completed in 2002. The challenge was to translate this into the other major languages of the world.
