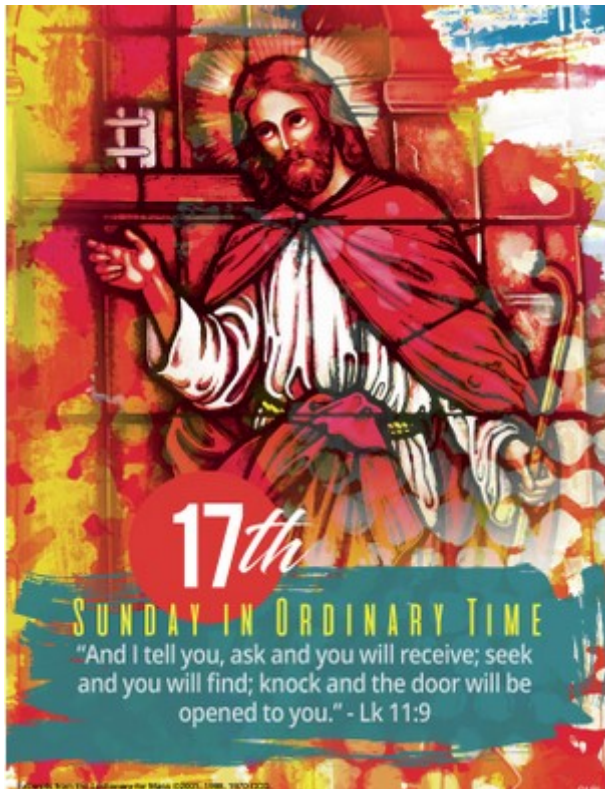

Notes from Deacon Denny

Over the last three "Notes" we spoke about defining "Common Good" and its three dimensions. We also asked the question: where are we called to action on our journey toward sainthood? The third dimension speaks of the coming together as a community, by defining issues through the grace we receive within our sacraments, as well as the gifts we have received as unique persons made in the image of God. When convening in the community to solve problems and issues that we face, that dynamic of the Holy Spirit within us guides us as co-creators to new, greater solutions and options.

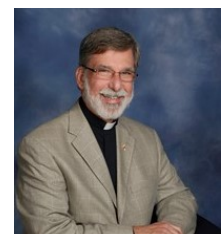
Interestingly, at a recent national Conference for Pastoral Planning and Council Development, a presentation by Bishop Emeritus Howard Hubbard spoke about the proceedings of Vatican II. The presentation referenced one of the Vatican II contributors, Karl Rahner. This paper by Rahner spoke of the direction that emerged initially after Vatican II for the Church going forward.

He eloquently articulated the Presence of the Holy Spirit being Present in the collaborative roles we are all called to play during any transition time, not only in the Church, but also in our individual lives. "I also do not doubt that such transitions happen for the most part and in the final analysis unreflectively; they are not first planned out theologically and then put into effect, but are unreflectively realized through a finely hidden instinct of the Spirit and of grace that remains mysterious - even though the element of reflection borne along with the action should certainly not be disregarded or considered superfluous."

Hmmm. Perhaps we should not be bashful to follow our hearts when called to action.
