Greetings of Peace as we enter into August.

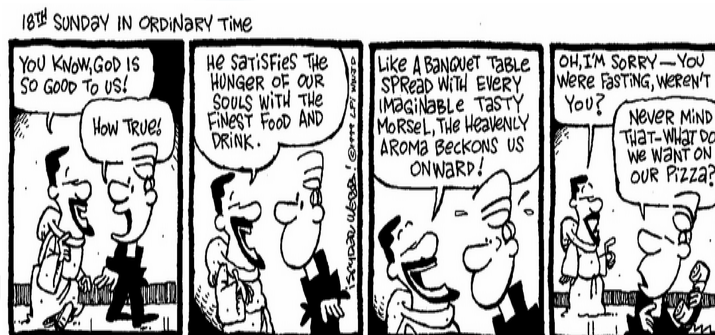
2). Visit the Apple Store or Google Play Store where you will find the free "Give + Church" smart phone app:

A Revised Roman Missal: The Words we Pray at Mass by Gary Joseph Malin



Because the liturgy is so important, the Congregation for Divine Worship and the Discipline of the Sacraments published a document "Liturgicam Authenticam" – a set of principles to guide the work of translation. The Congregation hoped that any translation would include the basic thoughts and key images of the Latin original and be as faithful as possible to the Latin word selection, grammar, and syntax. The bulk of the translation was done by two committees made up of liturgical scholars and bishops: ICEL (the International Commission for English in the Liturgy) and "Vox Clara." The translation was done in stages, then approved by the bishops, and then sent to Rome for official approval.

Praying with the Universal Church

It is hoped that the revised translation of the Missal (begun in Advent 2011) would capture the "splendor of Latin original." Perhaps we notice at mass that the Revised Missal incorporates a greater use of Scripture and has more poetic imagery than the former Sacramentary we used for over 40 years. The revised Missal also helps the Universal Church celebrate the Mass in a more uniform fashion.

Yes, the new translation presented (and continues to present) some challenges. Change is always difficult, especially in the Mass – something so important to us as Catholic-Christians. Everyone is still adjusting as we learn these prayers. We all "mess up" our lines, at times. However, the language of the new translation serves to elevate our minds and hearts into the mystery we celebrate. Ultimately, the revised translation of the mass should give us an opportunity to better appreciate God's love for us, given so freely and so fully in the Eucharist.

Again, **"The Mass has not changed, the translation has."** The new translation has a different style and has put different words into the mouths of both worshipers and ministers. It is hoped that it is worth the effort.

Ultimately, the revised Missal attempts to do better what no translation can do adequately: give us words to praise our God.
