Greetings of Peace.

Each year in the fall, all churches in the Diocese of Cleveland do "A Count." This "count" also takes place in most of the USA. It is a good indicator to see how many Catholics are attending mass and how many Catholics are actually practicing their faith.

In the past few years, the mass attendance numbers at St. Joan of Arc (and throughout our diocese, in the USA, as well as other countries) have trended downward. You can see from the numbers, below, there are fewer people attending mass (on average) this year than there were even as recently as 5 years ago.

Average attendance per weekend at St. Joan of Arc From 10 years ago, and 5 years ago to this year (rounded to the nearest "5") 2011 1,225 2016 1,100 2017 975 2018 905 2019 860 2020 * 270 2021 * 550

In 2021, the average attendance per mass was: Sat 4:30 #165, Sun 9 AM #172, Sun 11 AM #217

*Note: The numbers from the years 2020 and 2021 are much lower because of the Covid pandemic, the fact that the bishop's dispensation from the obligation to attend mass was still in effect, the pandemic was still reflecting surging numbers of Covid cased, and many public safety protocols were still mandated. The year 2020 was particularly low.

The above trends show some realties that must be faced – and it seems to me that these are quite significant. Mass attendance impacts our collections, it is evidenced in the fact that we now have one priest at St. Joan (when in 2013 we had two full time priests), and also impacts the number of people in our parish who are available to participate in ministries, groups, committees, and so on.

Now St. Joan of Arc is not unique in this matter — it is reflected in most parts of the USA. Still, the trend is very interesting. I wonder what this says about how Catholics are committed to the faith? Recent studies have shown under 27% of Catholics attend mass on a regular basis (before the pandemic). Additionally, studies have shown that those who do come are often less involved in the life of the church.

In the diocese of Cleveland, we ordained 3 men as priests in the spring of 2021. You know as well as I do that there are more than 3 priests who will, retire, die, or otherwise be able to do ministry in the next year. Let me ask this: If what we do in church (with mass, sacraments, baptisms, funerals, weddings, etc.) is important to us as Catholics, then who will be the ones to do this priestly work in the future? A retired priest told to me (when I asked him for mass help), "I think the middle-aged clergy are being worked to death and need all the help they can get...I will help when I can; but for me, over age 80, I don't know what I can continue to do..."

Again, I wanted to communicate all this to you and offer it for your perusal! Thank you for your faith and for your presence at St. Joan of Arc. Christmas is two weeks away! For your planning, our Christmas mass schedule is:

* Christmas Eve, Friday December 24: 4:30 PM and 8:00 PM

* Christmas Day, Saturday December 25: 9:00 AM and 11:00 AM

-There will not be a 4:30 PM mass on Saturday December 25

-Sunday December 26, we will follow our regular Sunday schedule: 9:00 AM and 11:00 AM

And more to note about Christmas. Christmas has been a time when many people usually come to mass! Christmas masses are usually quite crowded. In today's world, that can be "a problem." For those who do choose to come to mass, we will still need to maintain our current protocols – and at this point the Bishop has asked all to continue to wear masks while in our worship space and buildings. We anticipate having some "overflow" directed to our Gym and hope to be able to livestream mass and also "deliver communion" there – particularly for the Christmas Eve 4:30 PM mass. Still, we will need to follow the appropriate safety measures in the gym as well. Furthermore, for those in "high risk" categories or other considerations could perhaps choose to remain home out of caution and for your own health. Finally, Christmas mass should be available on the St. Joan of Arc Parish website.

Finally, there will be an Advent Communal Penance Service at Resurrection in Solon on Monday December 13 at 6:30 PM and at St. Rita on Tuesday December 21 at 7 PM.
