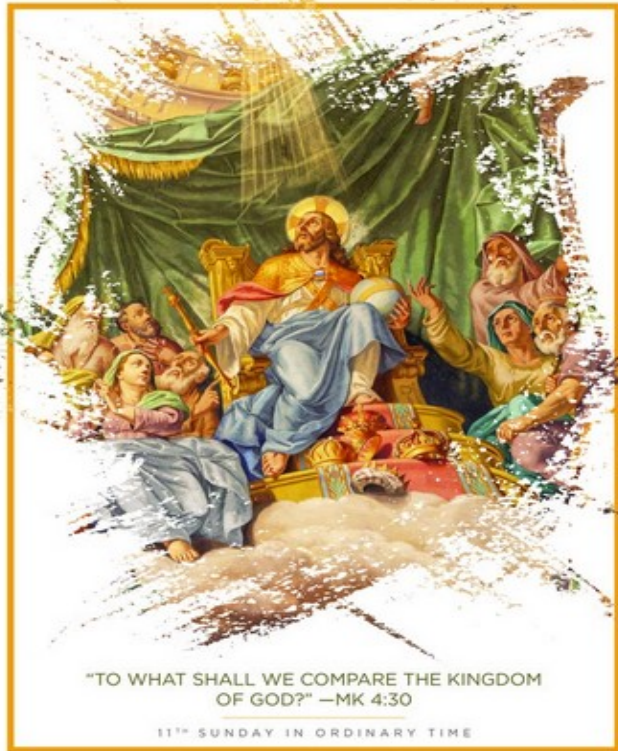

Greetings of peace.

Across the Diocese of Cleveland the end of the dispensation from attending mass on Sundays and Holy Days of obligation took effect June 5-6, as directed by Bishop Malesic. At the same time many pandemic-imposed safety guidelines were eliminated. For example, face masks and social distancing are no longer required in churches throughout the Diocese. However, Diocesan officials strongly suggest that those not yet vaccinated or who are otherwise vulnerable continue to wear a face mask (which covers both one's nose and mouth). They also urge that respect be shown to those following guidelines issued by the CDC, state and local entities, and those who, for personal reasons, choose to continue wearing a face mask and follow social distancing. Additionally, use of all seating areas in church is permitted.



*The Bishop reminds the faithful that the dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and holy days of obligation remains in effect for those who are ill, have health risk factors, or care for someone who is immune compromised or ill, as well as those who have significant fear or anxiety of contracting coronavirus in a large group of persons, or other serious reason.*

I say, thank you for your faith, presence, and patience in the midst of all we have been through this past year. Our "return to church" is all still a work in progress and will do the best we can as we navigate through these changing times.



In our parish, we have had in recent bulletins an invitation to participate in a "Celebration of Sr. Judy." Sr. Judith Bucco, SND, has been our parish Director of Religious Education (DRE) for the past 15 years. Sr. Judy is retiring at the end of this month after her faithful and dedicated service here at St. Joan of Arc. We will celebrate with Sr. Judy on Sunday afternoon, July 11, at Frohring Meadows. All are welcome to come and express our gratitude for Sr. Judy and her generous service at St. Joan of Arc. Speaking of our Director of Religious Education role at St. Joan of Arc, I am happy to announce that Mrs. Amanda T. Haberman will be transitioning from here current role as our Parish Pastoral Minister to become our next full-time DRE. Amanda has been a wonderful Parish Pastoral Minister and her many gifts and talents will be beneficial to our parish as she becomes our next Director of Religious Education. As a result, we will have begun the search for a new Pastoral Minister to serve here at St. Joan of Arc to take on the role Amanda has faithfully carried out.

Additionally, we are in need of someone (or perhaps a small group of people) to take on the some of the duties of a "Sacristan." *Jeanette Behlow served as our Parish Sacristan for over 50 years and before Christmas 2020, she decided it was time for her to retire. We shared this news with you at that time. We are "eternally grateful" for Jeanette's dedicated service over the years. We hope to enlist another (or others) to help care for our altar area, vessels, sacred furnishings, candles, altar cloths and linens, and more in the role as "Sacristan."* Stay tuned!
