As I wrote the past couple of weeks, we may be aware that Pope Francis began a process of a "Synod on Synodality" within the worldwide Church to "...explore the nature of the Church, its from, style and mission." The faithful in our diocese are being offered opportunities to "share their thoughts on the Church" at "listening sessions." Bishop Malesic recently said, "...(A)s a Church on a journey, questions might arise such as how do we walk together, better? And on the way, how do we evangelize the word with the fire of faith? Or, how do we improve our engagement with people on the peripheries?" According to the bishop, "The purpose of the process is not to gather personal opinions, but to 'listen to the Holy Spirit,' as Pope Francis said."

Our listening session here at St. Joan of Arc will be on Wednesday, March 23 at 6:30pm in the hall. Dr. Andrew Trew, a parishioner, will facilitate our session. All are welcome. The information gathered will be summarized and submitted nationally and then to Rome - where, in 2023, the Synod of Bishops will gather to reflect on what the Church is saying. May the Holy Spirit guide us all on our journey of faith as the people of God.

This week on Friday, March 25, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Annunciation of the Lord. Solemnities are not observed as penitential days. Therefore, by virtue of the law (CIC 1251) and the liturgical nature of the day, penitential practices like fasting or abstaining from eating meat, are not required on this day, even through it falls on a Friday in Lent.

The Diocese of Cleveland is offering a "Catholic Men's Conference" on Saturday, April 2, at the Holiday Inn 6011 Rockside Rd in Independence, OH. Arrival and sign-in begins at 8am and the conference starts at 9am and concludes with mass at 4pm. More information is available on the poster on our kiosk in the Gathering Area. Those wishing to attend need to register for the conference and forms are available in the Lobby.

The faithful throughout the Catholic Diocese of Cleveland will have an opportunity to provide financial assistance to the war victims in Ukraine as well as to support other projects in Central and Eastern Europe through the annual Collection to Aid the Church in Central and Eastern Europe. The collection is sanctioned by the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) and is taken up in diocesan parishes in the Lenten season.

Here at St. Joan of Arc, we will have a basket in the Gathering Area the weekend of March 26-27 for those who wish to contribute, or you can place your gift in our regular collection marked "Eastern Europe" on the envelope and on the memo line of a check. Checks should be made out to ST. JOAN OF ARC.

Our diocesan Bishop Edward C. Malesic is a member of the USCCB Subcommittee on Aid to the Church in Central and Eastern Europe.

The USCCB is uniquely positioned to provide aid to the region, having built strong relationships with bishops there these last 30 years, and will allow the Church in the USA to be a strong partner in the rebuilding and restoring of the Church in Central and Eastern Europe – and to give critical and timely humanitarian aid now for Ukraine. May the intercession of Our Lady, Queen of Peace, help bring a swift end to the violence.


There will be a car in the SJA parking lot this Thursday, March 24, from 10-11 for you to drop off food donations. The list of needs for this week is:

2. Visit the Apple App Store or Google Play Store, where you will find the free "Give + Church" smart phone app.




