Millie loves to "journey" with people and groups in faith and is looking forward to getting to know us at St. Joan of Arc. And more on "service." In a few weeks, on Sunday, June 12, 2022 at 1:00pm, Fr. John R. Olsavsky will celebrate a mass of thanksgiving here at St. Joan as he celebrates 60 years as an ordained priest. A reception/gathering will follow in the gym - known as the Olsavsky Center. Fr. John served as our pastor from 1988 until his retirement in 2006. Fr. John is "Pastor Emeritus." We look forward to celebrating with him in a few weeks. All are welcome. Moreover, if anyone is interested and able to volunteer their help, particularly for the reception after the mass on Sunday, June 12, please contact our parish office. Thank. Congratulations, Fr. John. We look forward to celebrating with you!

For those who would like to schedule "mass intentions" - there are a number of our upcoming "daily masses" that do not have intentions listed in our "parish book. Intentions could be, for example, for someone on or near their birthday, anniversary, for the repose of the soul of someone who has died, etc. The custom of mass intentions invites the faithful into a deeper celebration of the Eucharist by uniting their sacrifice with that of Christ. When mass is celebrated, the priest offers the mass in acord with the norms of the teachings of the church and sacred liturgy. We also remember that the mass is offered in union with and for the church - in which we pray for "the Church," its leaders, the people of God, the needs of our world, and more. And so we realize that God directs the fruits of the mass, which are infinite and universal. Still, within the context of this theology, a particular intention may be specified at mass - such as those listed above. Although there is no "requirement' to do so, the intention is often mentioned at that mass during the "Universal Prayer" or the "Prayer of the Faithful." A donation of \$10 is asked for a mass intention. Please contact our parish office during our regular business hours if you would like to find out what dates and times are available to schedule a particular mass intention.

This week, please note an adjustment of our "daily mass schedule" on Thursday, May 26. The parish morning mass will be at 10am on Thursday of this week, rather than 8am. Our parish school will attend this 10am mass on Thursday and we will recognize our 8th graders, who will be graduating. Congratulations and God be with ou as you move on to High School.

Finally, looking ahead. Beginning in June - and through the "summer months" of June, July, and august - our Tuesday morning mass will be celebrated at 8am. Again, this begins in June.
