Greetings of Easter Peace. We proclaim, "He is risen. He is risen, indeed. Alleluia!" We conclude the Easter Season as we celebrate Pentecost this weekend. As we "breathe in" and "breathe out" God's Pentecost spirit in our midst, we can pause as another busy year in our parish community slows down a bit. Yes, we often follow the "school year" for activities and "programs" in the parish. I hope it has been a fulfilling and enriching year for you. And as we approach summer – which begins in a couple of weeks – and summer's slower pace – I pray that we can experience God's presence in nature, in our families, friends, and community. Amen.

There are quite a few "Holy Spirit Prayers" that we can use. One is the prayer that begins, "Come Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of the faithful..." Another is St. Augustine's beloved prayer which says, "Breathe in me, O Holy Spirit, that my thoughts may all be holy. Act in me, O Holy Spirit, that my work, too, may be holy. Draw my heart, O Holy Spirit, that I love but what is holy. Strengthen me, O Holy Spirit, to defend all that is holy. Guard me, then, O Holy Spirit, that I always may be holy." I like a "Spirit Psalm" that is inspired by the image of the Spirit rushing upon David when he was anointed King (1 Samuel 16/13). It asks the same Holy Spirit to "Rush upon us as it did upon King David.

Rush upon us, O Spirit of God! From this time on, rush upon us
like living water, like leaping fire, like fresh breath through an open window.

For this time, rush upon us, O Holy Spirit, with wisdom and knowledge,
with understanding and counsel, with wonder and recognition and awe.

Just in time, rush upon us, O Spirit of God,
in life-giving words, in songs from the voiceless, in passion for witness.

At this time, rush upon us, O Holy Spirit; this hopeful time, this searching time,
this preparing time, this coming and going time,
this trusting time, this new time, this full time.

All the time, Rush upon us, O Spirit of God! Amen. Alleluia!

Yes, this Spirit Psalm says it well! Now, each of us can live – inspired by the Holy Spirit!

Since we are now in the month of June – beginning this month – and through the "summer months" of June, July, and August – our Tuesday AM mass will be celebrated at 8 AM. Thank you for making a note of this. Once the school year begins and we reach Labor Day (in September) the Tuesday morning mass will move to 9 AM so we can pray and celebrate with our parish school. Until that time, the Tuesday morning mass will be at 8 AM these "summer months."

Next weekend, on Sunday June 12, we will celebrate 60 years of ordination with our Pastor Emeritus (former pastor, retired), Fr. John R. Olsavsky. Fr. John will be here for a mass of thanksgiving at 1 PM followed by a reception in the "Olsavsky Center" (gym). All are welcome. Congratulations, Fr John! Have a great week, blessings for Pentecost and the month of June! You are in my prayers.
