

ALSO, PSR AND OUR DRE MRS. MARY VINCENTI ARE LOOKING AHEAD TO ANOTHER GREAT YEAR AND PREPARING WELL.

LOOKING AHEAD TO SEPTEMBER, THE "DAILY MASS" IN THE PARISH ON TUESDAYS WILL BE CELEBRATED AT 9 AM THROUGHOUT THE SCHOOL YEAR. (IN JUNE, JULY, AND AUGUST, THE MASS IS 8 AM ON TUESDAYS. DURING THE "ACADEMIC YEAR" WE SHIFT THE TIME TO 9 AM SO OUR SCHOOL FAMILY ARE ABLE TO JOIN THE PARISH AT DAILY MASS.) THANK YOU FOR NOTING THE TUESDAY MORNING MASS WILL BE AT 9 AM STARTING IN SEPTEMBER. AND LOOKING FURTHER AHEAD TO LABOR DAY – SINCE SEPTEMBER IS NOT VERY FAR AWAY – MONDAY SEPTEMBER 5 IS LABOR DAY. MASS ON LABOR DAY WILL BE 9 AM.
