This week we celebrate the Assumption of Mary into Heaven on Tuesday August 15 - a HolyDay of Obligation. Our masses will be at 9 AM and 7 PM on Tuesday, August 15. Where Mary has gone, we hope to follow!


This is being written on Monday August 7, and the "special election" on Issue One in Ohio has not yet taken place (as of this writing). That election is tomorrow. Still, I received numerous memos from the Diocese of Cleveland and the Ohio Bishops about the election that will be held on November 7, 2023. In part, a letter of 7/31/2023 from the diocese said, "The amendment to enshrine abortion into the Ohio Constitution will officially be on the November 7, 2023 ballot. The church must not be silent and cannot remain on the sidelines when confronted with such a clear threat to human life. Therefore, the Catholic Conference of Ohio (CCO) in collaboration with the Catholic dioceses across the state...is informing Catholics in Ohio about the dangers of the amendment and encourage them to vote no..."

In addition, the church has also said the following

- -Please vote!
- -Secondly, we should allow our faith influence us as we form our consciences as we seek to become informed on issues and candidates...
- -Thirdly, the Church does not support or oppose particular candidates; the church does seek to focus attention on the moral and human dimensions of issues. More will be shared on this on a regular basis until the November election as Bishop Malesic and the Ohio bishops have instructed. Stay tuned!

I hope you have a great week. You are in my heart and in my prayers.

Funerals: Please contact the parish office before scheduling or publishing (generally through a funeral director).



BUILDING COMMON GROUND Notes from Deacon Denny

In light of where we are today as the Parish of St. Joan of Arc, in the Catholic Diocese of Cleveland, Ohio, facing the challenges we face today, in light of our synod discussions in recent months, where do we begin? To build a community of Faith that supports each other and in particular our new parents in responding to their needs.

Baptism

Baptism is when we gather as family, usually with our infant or young children to celebrate the Rite of Baptism. Three different questions regularly emerge.

- As a Sacramental Church, what do we learn from the Rite and our Traditions about welcoming this new life into the "Body of Christ", beginning their journey toward becoming a Saint?
- As parents, Godparents, family and church community; how do we stand together in support by sharing our beliefs and "moral compass", to help them on their journey?
 - How do we support these families with these new responsibilities, in today's world?

Over the last several years, in preparing families for the Rite of Baptism, a number of additional questions routinely come up, from the family perspective.

- 2 What are the reasons and meanings behind the Rite of Baptism from which we can learn?
- When preparing parents for Baptism, often, a spouse has not had the benefit of leaning many of the beautiful aspects of our Catholic Faith, what can we do for them in supporting the upbringing of our children?
- Along with our Faith & Spiritual development support of each other, as a faith-based community, how do we connect to each other as a Church to better understand our community and the issues facing families today?

This Note is announcing the initiative to build responses to these and related questions as well. Over the last several months a number of Parishioners and new families to our Parish have expressed an interest in developing a new initiative by creating a new ministry at SJA. Yet to be officially named, "New Family" or "Family Ministry", is calling for input as to how we become Church for one another. Among dozens of suggestions, they include;

- 2 More involvement from Parishioners in the preparation and participation in Baptisms.
- Evolution of the RCIA program to include "as a refresher" or "tell me more first".
- A potential web site or community connection to post info and build community.

Special Note:

To receive the sacrament of Eucharist in 2nd grade, two years of regular religious education are required. Therefore, if you have a child entering 1st grade this school year, please make sure to register him/her in our SJA Parish School of Religion for the 2023-2024 school year. To receive the sacrament of Confirmation in 8th grade, two years of regular religious education are required. Therefore, if you have a child entering 7th grade this school year, please make sure to register him/her in our SJA Parish School of Religion for the 2023-2024 school year. For Confirmation in 8th grade, in addition to attendance of a regular religious education class, attendance in our supplemental Confirmation preparation program will be required. If your child attends a Catholic school, they do not need to attend our PSR classes, however, for Confirmation as an 8th grader, they will need to register for our Confirmation preparation program only.

We are in need of additional adult singers, age high school through senior citizens as well as new handbell ringers and hope to form a children's choir from our day school and PSR student bodies. Singers will be asked to meet with Jon Thibo, Director of Music for a brief singalong to identify voice part, we particularly need male voices. Handbell Ringers with musical background are preferred, though the ability to read music is not a requirement as music can be marked with colors to identify which bells are played when, so long as the ringer can count and keep a steady beat. Ringers from grades 8 through high school and all adults are welcome to join our newly reformed Handbell Choir. Children's Choir will be for students grades 2-8 and will meet at a time convenient to all families. Further details will be in the first bulletin of September as all our ensembles will be rehearsing during the months of September through May.
