Greetings of Peace.

This column was written in late November to early December, since "due dates" for our parish bulletin are adjusted around "holidays" and there is a new "program" for submitting our bulletin to the "bulletin company."

When the days were cold and the nights were long and our need for a Savior was great, God sent his son to us! Yes, Christmas comes upon us "this coming weekend." Christmas is Monday December 25 this year.

Please note this year there is the obligation to attend mass for both "the weekend" of December 23-24 as well as for Christmas. The St. Joan of Arc weekend and Christmas mass schedule is:

Weekend of Saturday-Sunday, December 23-24

4:30 PM mass on Saturday December 23

11:00AM mass on Sunday December 24

-- ** Note no 9:00AM mass on Sunday December 24 **

Christmas Eve, Sunday December 24

4:30 PM mass and 8:00 PM mass

Christmas Day, Monday December 25

9:00 AM mass and 11:00 AM mass

Also note there will not be a "daily morning mass" in the parish on Friday December 22 or on Tuesday December 26.

On Monday night, December 18, there will be an Advent "Area Communal Penance Service" at St. Rita at 6:00 PM. Looking ahead to the last weekend of December 2023 and New Years 2024, which is Monday January 1, 2024, we will have our regular weekend mass schedule for Saturday and Sunday,

December 30-31 - that is Saturday mass is 4:30 PM; Sunday mass at 9:00AM and 11:00AM.

Since New Years is on a Monday, the obligation to go to mass on New Years is dispensed. Still, we will have one mass on New Years, Monday January 1, 2024 at 9:00 AM for those who wish to participate. And because of the holiday, there will not be a "daily morning mass" on Tuesday January 2, 2024. Blessings and Peace as we approach Christmas and the New Year.










FOOD PANTRY COLLECTION IN THE NARTHEX

NEW OPPORTUNITY TO SUPPORT OUR STUDENTS!

Ohioans can now receive a 100% tax credit of up to \$750 (\$1,500 for married couples filing jointly) for donations to the Angel Scholarship Fund. The aim of this tax-credit scholarship program is to award scholarships for elementary and high school students. This is a great opportunity to provide tuition assistance for families who wish to send their children to our Catholic schools.

NEW in 2023!

HB 33 passed by the Ohio State legislature in July 2023, extended the scholarship tax credit deadline- donors now have until April 15, 2024 to make a contribution to the Angel Scholarship Fund that is eligible for a 1:1 state tax credit in 2023.
