

From the Pastor

Greetings of Peace early in the Lenten Season.

Our parish family is inviting you to join us for a "parish mission," which will focus on reconciliation and the rewards that come with God's forgiveness. A "mission" is a special time for us to gather and gain insight into a faith filled life. We welcome Fr. Tom Blau, a Dominican Friar from Columbus and a Cleveland native who will lead a 3-night presentation and discussion about how to live a moral life, beyond mere commandments, with opportunities to ask questions about Catholic moral teaching, confession, and reconciliation. The Mission will be Sunday, Monday, and Tuesday evenings, February 26, 27, and 28.

On Friday February 17th I received a memo from Bishop Malesic requesting parishes to place the following in parish bulletins to help support relief efforts in Turkey and Syria. "The February 6 earthquake that struck Turkey and Syria has caused the deaths of more than 40,000 people, injured countless more, and devastated the Turkish and Syrian people who are mourning unimaginable losses." Bishop Edward C. Malesic is requesting the prayers of the faithful for all those impacted by this disaster, and is asking those who are able, to give generously to support relief efforts.

Funerals: Please contact the parish office before scheduling or publishing (generally through a funeral director).



STATIONS OF THE CROSS/SOUP SUPPER


