

From the Pastor

Greetings of peace.



This bulletin has an early due date because of our parish office staffing schedule and the July 4 holiday, so it is being written in mid-June! My, how time flies. We are less than 6 months away from Christmas 2023 and the New Year 2024! I hope the warmth of God's love fills you with his goodness and blessings during these summer days.

Since we are in the midst of summer, might I offer a reminder. My intent is to continue to communicate with you as best as I can. One way is through this bulletin column. At times, the column may be long; other weeks it may be brief. In some weeks, though, I may not have a bulletin column. I have shared this in the past. A priest-friend says this about writing in his parish bulletin, "I say what needs to be said!" That sums it up pretty well! Here is a "reflection" called "God Won't Ask" – back by popular demand. It is pretty powerful. I have made many good-faith efforts to find the "the source" of this narrative and all have said, "Unknown." If someone is aware, please let me know so I can give due credit. Thank you.

- -God won't ask the square footage of your house; he will ask how many people you welcomed
- -God won't ask how many fancy clothes you had in your closet; he will ask how many you helped clothe and were in need
- -God won't ask how many friends you had; he'll as how many people to whom you were a friend
- -God won't ask in what neighborhood you lived; he will ask how you treated your neighbors
- God won't ask about the color of your skin; he will ask about the content of your character
- -God won't ask how many material possessions you had; he will ask whether those possessions dictated your life
- -God won't ask how much overtime you worked; he will ask did about the time you spent loving others
- -God won't ask how many promotions you received; he will ask what you did to promote others
- —God won't ask what your job title was; he will ask did you perform your job to the best of your ability
- -God won't ask how many times your deeds matched your words; he may ask about the times they didn't
- -God won't ask about what got in the way of seeking salvation; he will lovingly welcome those who love him into the gates of heaven.

Finally, looking ahead, I will be out to town beginning Tuesday July 18 (after the 8 AM morning mass) and will return for the morning mass on Friday July 28. While I am away there will not be a daily mass in the parish those days. More in next week's bulletin.

Funerals: Please contact the parish office before scheduling or publishing (generally through a funeral director).





Sholarship awards for the Angel Scholarship Fund were recently submitted to the Catholic Community Foundation. The school was able to offer awards to 62 students from 39 different families. 
PSR
