Plant of the Week—June 23, 2024

Opuntia humifusa- Eastern Prickly Pear or Devil's Tongue



Plant Type: Evergreen perennial cactus (yes that's correct, a hardy cactus native to Ohio) that blooms during late spring to early summer.

Bloom: Yellow flower with reddish center, followed by reddish-orange to purple edible fruit. Jams and jellies are made from the fruit.

Culture: Full sun on a sandy to gravelly well drained neutral soil.

Biblical Connection: Devil's tongue so it brings the devil into the garden and his qualities that make our lives difficult at times and the holy family may have eaten the fruit of this plants cousin Opuntia ficus-indica in their homes and travels.

Where: In the 2nd quadrant to the right in the center circle of the GOL

Stachys byzantine- Lamb's Ear

Plant Type: Herbaceous perennial with wooly leaves that resemble a lamb's ear.

Bloom: Magenta inconspicuous flowers on flower stalks which rise above the plant..

Culture: Sun in average well drained soils.

Biblical Connection: This plant comes from the Byzantine area and is associated with meekness as in Jesus the "Lamb of God".

Where: On the outer ring in the interior of the GOL..

June 23rd is International Widows Day

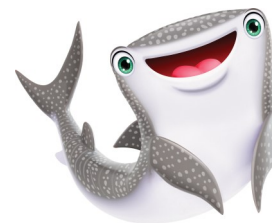
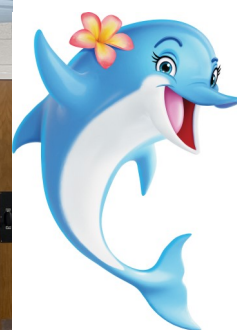
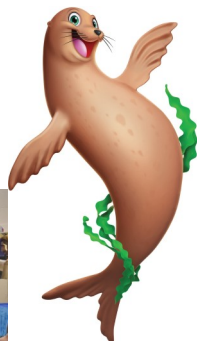
