

#### From the Pastor

#### Greetings of Peace.



We are entering the third week of our Lenten journey and it is hard to believe that Easter is less than a month away. We also "spun our clocks ahead one hour" on Saturday March 11. We lose one hour of sleep and gain daylight in the evening. Very soon we will enter the Season of Spring! This weekend, March 11-12, we eavesdrop on an encounter between Jesus and the Woman at the Well, from chapter 4 of the Gospel of John. And what an encounter it is. In her thirst for water, she spiritually thirsts for Jesus. Then she becomes a witness who leads people to Jesus, who is living water. Since Lent is "all about baptism," this encounter is very appropriate. In baptism we are immersed into the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus. This Gospel shows us that Jesus is our source of living water – and our very life. In truth, only Jesus quenches our thirst. Amen!

And this week we celebrate St. Patrick Day on Friday, March 17. As I shared last week – I share again. Bishop Edward Malesic issued the following statement regarding numerous requests for dispensation from obligation to abstain from eating meat on St. Patrick's Day. The bishop said, "Throughout the season of Lent we are invited to participate in the opportunity for prayer, fasting and almsgiving in order to deepen are awareness and better appreciate the ultimate sacrifice Jesus made for us on Good Friday. This year, St. Patrick's Day falls on a Friday in Lent, and several have inquired about the possibility of a dispensation from the obligation to abstain from eating meat on Fridays in Lent.

"After prayerful consideration, I am granting this dispensation from the obligation to abstain from meat for those who feel it absolutely necessary to be dispensed in order to celebrate the Feast of St. Patrick. I ask that those who exercise this dispensation and eat meat on the Feast of St. Patrick to select another non-Friday day during Lent to abstain from eating meat or to make some offering on behalf of the poor, whether by prayer, fasting or almsgiving. Be assured of my prayers for all the faithful who continue to strive to imitate the joy of the saints and follow their example with the same seriousness and commitment with which they practiced their faith.

"May God bless you and those you love."

Finally, and Lenten note about Reconciliation. This week there will be a Lenten Communal Penance Service on Wednesday March 15 at 7:00 PM at Resurrection in Solon and next week at St. Rita on Tuesday March 21 at 6:30 PM. Moreover, confessions are offered here at St. Joan on most Saturdays throughout the year. Generally, confessions are on Saturdays at 3:30 PM until all are heard. In Advent and Lent confessions are heard on Saturdays from 3:15 PM until 4:00 PM – however, not on Holy Saturday afternoon, which is April 8 this year.

I hope you have a blessed week and seek the way of the Lord in the journey of Lent
