Greetings of Easter Peace. He is Risen. He is Risen, indeed. Alleluia!

Here is an Easter story – back by popular demand! Remember when Dick Feagler's beloved stories about "Christmas at Aunt Ida's" appeared in the Newspaper each year? Maybe this story is becoming a tradition at St. Joan of Arc!

A teacher brought "egg-like" panty hose containers" to her religion class of young students. Each student received one and were instructed to go outside on that lovely spring day and find some symbol for "new life" and put it in the plastic egg.

After each student hunted for their sign of new life, they returned to the classroom.

Some other students said to Billy, "You don't ever do things right!"

Just when the teacher was about to begin to bring order to the classroom, "Little Billy" exclaimed, "I did do it right. There's nothing there! It's empty. The tomb is empty!"

Silence followed and the lesson was learned.

We also welcome those who were received into the Catholic church with us here at St. Joan of Arc at the Easter vigil mass. Welcome. We are glad you are part of us in faith! Nice!!

Please save the date of April 25th for the Annual Women's Guild Spring Luncheon.






