

From the Pastor

Greetings of Peace as we celebrate the Second Sunday of Lent. The gospel this weekend is the Transfiguration of Jesus on the Mountain. This gospel is proclaimed each year on Lent's Second Sunday. One author said maybe we need a glimpse of light, hope, and goodness early on our Lenten journey! Let's allow God's light to shine through us the way it did with Jesus on the mountain!

Throughout our Diocese, parishes will offer an "Evening of Confessions" this week on Wednesday, March 8. "Healing Begins Here" is the theme this year. Here at St. Joan of Arc, I will be available for confessions from 6 PM until about 715 PM in church. I will also have some information about the sacrament in the Gathering Area on that evening. Moreover, confessions are offered here at St. Joan on most Saturdays throughout the year. Generally, confessions are on Saturdays at 330 PM until all are heard. And in Advent and Lent confessions are heard on Saturdays from 315 PM until 4:00 PM – except Holy Saturday, which is April 8 this year. Other opportunities for the Sacrament of Reconciliation will be at "Communal Penance Services" in our area. Locally, Resurrection in Solon has a Communal Penance on Wednesday March 15 at 700PM and St Rita in Solon on Tuesday March 21 at 630 PM.


We also know that time is moving quickly! It is already the month of March! And this coming Saturday, March 11, we "Turn our Clocks Ahead one hour" – spring forward – and begin Daylight Savings Time. This is a sure sign of spring, although we often get a good snowfall or two before April! Now that we are in the month of March, Bishop Edward Malesic has issued the following statement regarding numerous requests for dispensation from obligation to abstain from eating meat on St. Patrick's Day, which falls on a Friday in Lent this year. The bishop said, "Throughout the season of Lent we are invited to participate in the opportunity for prayer, fasting and almsgiving in order to deepen our awareness and better appreciate the ultimate sacrifice Jesus made for us on Good Friday. This year, St. Patrick's Day falls on a Friday in Lent, and several have inquired about the possibility of a dispensation from the obligation to abstain from eating meat on Fridays in Lent.

"After prayerful consideration, I am granting this dispensation from the obligation to abstain from meat for those who feel it absolutely necessary to be dispensed in order to celebrate the Feast of St. Patrick. I ask that those who exercise this dispensation and eat meat on the Feast of St. Patrick to select another non-Friday day during Lent to abstain from eating meat or to make some offering on behalf of the poor, whether by prayer, fasting or almsgiving. Be assured of my prayers for all the faithful who continue to strive to imitate the joy of the saints and follow their example with the same seriousness and commitment with which they practiced their faith.

"May God bless you and those you love."

Funerals: Please contact the parish office before scheduling or publishing (generally through a funeral director).


