## From the Pastor

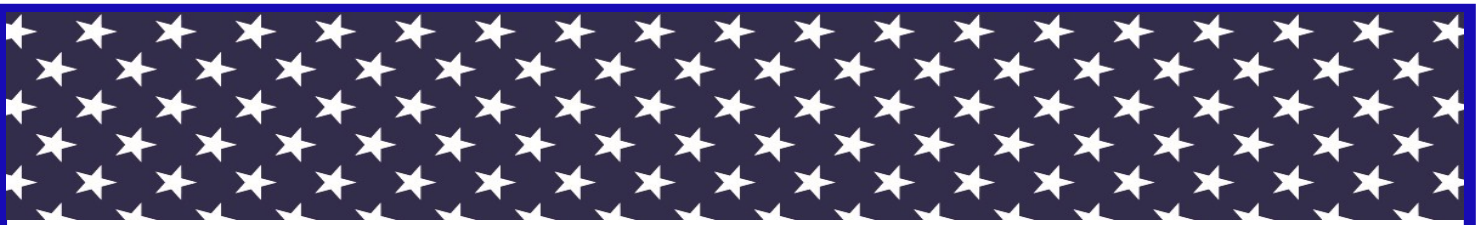

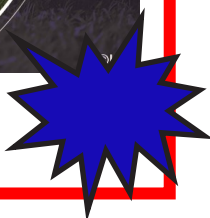

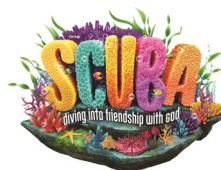

## In the Garden with Tony Colini



### Plant of the week May 27, 2024

#### **Alchellia mollis- Our Lady's Mantle**

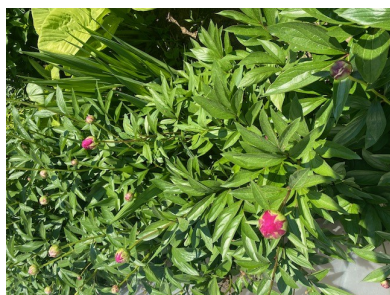
**Plant Type:** Herbaceous perennial that blooms in May – June.

**Bloom:** Yellow compound flowers on stems above the foliage.

**Culture:** Partial shade to sun.

**Biblical Connection:** Blooms around Ascension with cloud like blooms of yellow. Named after the shape of the leaves which look like a dress or skirt Mary might have worn (mantle).

**Where:** In the GOL inner quadrants.



#### **Paeonia officinalis- Pentecost Rose or Our Lady's Rose**

**Plant type:** Herbaceous perennial that blooms around Pentecost or near Memorial Day.

**Bloom:** Passion purple to reddish purple, rose, white, even yellow varieties have been developed. Rose shaped flowers with a sweet fragrance.

**Culture:** Plant full sun in good well drained soil; avoid wet soils.

**Biblical connection:** Blooms to welcome in the birth of the church and blooms in May the month of Mary hence Our Lady's Rose.

**Where:** In the Garden of Life on the perimeters of the Rosary.
