

Did You Know....from the SJA Bible Study Group

The prayers of Mass are almost entirely scriptural.

If Catholics were asked what parts of the Mass came directly from the Bible, the easy answers would be:

1) The words used in the Eucharistic Prayer "This is my body... this is the chalice of my blood..." are in gospel accounts of the Last Supper. (Mt 26:26-28/ Mk 14:22-24/ Lk 22: 17-20)

2) The readings in the Liturgy of the Word are from both the Old and New Testament

3) The Lord's Prayer (Mt 6:9-13/ Lk 11: 2-4)

Using **What We Believe; the Beauty of the Catholic Faith** by Marcellino D'Ambrosio and Andrew Swafford, over the next few weeks we will highlight other parts of the Mass and their biblical points of reference.
